1. Introduction

3. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect to:

We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information to third parties for marketing purposes.

We retain your information only as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this policy, or as required by law. Business contact information gathered from public sources is deleted upon opt-out request.

8. Third-Party Services

We may use third-party services including:

- **Twilio:** For SMS text message delivery.
- **Google:** For business data and analytics.
- **Webflow:** For website hosting.
- **Gmail / SMTP:** For email delivery.

These services have their own privacy policies and we encourage you to review them.

9. Security

We take reasonable precautions to protect your information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. However, no method of transmission over the Internet is 100% secure.

10. Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Request access to the personal information we hold about you.
- Request correction or deletion of your information.
- Opt out of communications at any time.
